



Albert Uderzo

Alberto Aleandro Uderzo was French but he was born Italian. He was born in April 1927 in Fismes in the Marne «departement» and his nickname was Albert Uderzo. He was the designer of the famous comic book *Astérix et Obélix*.

With his friend René Goscinny, Albert Uderzo made the first Astérix's book in 1959. Its name was *Astérix le Gaulois*. He met a great success with the public and in 1962 the two friends made the second Astérix's book: *La Serpe d'or*. The adventure began for Albert Uderzo and René Goscinny.

But in 1977, after 24 Astérix's books, René Goscinny died. Albert Uderzo continued Asterix's adventure up to the year 2009. The scenarist Jean-Yves Ferri and the designer Didier Conrad continued Astérix's books. In March 2020, Albert Uderzo died finally... of Corona-Virus. He was 92 years old.
