• In 1994 (he was 15 years old), he created a rap group named "Psy 4 de la Rime" with Alonzo (another French rapper), Vincenzo and a childhood friend: DJ Sya Styles. In 1998, they became a little bit famous.

- He started a solo career in 2006 and his first success landed in thanks to his first album: Puisqu'il faut vivre.
- A new mixtape in 2010: De *Puisqu'il faut vivre* à *La colombe*.
- A new album in 2011: Le corbeau.
- He became really famous, thanks to his music he was nominated at the NRJ Music Awards!
- A new album in 2014: *Cosmopolitanie*. Soprano is an artist who fights against racism and discrimination. He sends strong messages of solidarity in his songs.
- In October 2015, his best friend DJ Sya styles died from a cancer. In his memory
 Soprano wrote a beautiful song named: Roule. He also wrote a song for his youngest
 daughter.
- October 2016, a new album: L'Everest. Nominated twice at the NRJ Music Awards.
- He was nominated again in 2017.
- On November 10, 2018, Soprano won the NRJ Music Award prize for "Francophone Artist of the Year".
- April 2019, a new album: Phoenix.

- In 2006, he got married with Alexia, the mother of his children. They have 3 children. Soprano's first daughter Inaya was born in 2007, His only son Lenny was born in 2009 and his younger daughter Luna was born in 2012.
- One of the most traumatizing things of his life happened when he was 16 years old: he had a child but his ex girlfriend gave him to the social services. Even now, he doesn't know who and where his son is.

- He had a house built for his parents in the Comoros so that they could take care of his grandma.
- Unfortunately, his father recently died from the COVID-19.
- In 2018 he founded a charity: The Soprano Foundation, which helps Comorian people. First, they collected clothes for orphans and then the foundation bought an ambulance because in the Comoros the patients' transportation is quite problematic because of poverty.
- He's also a UNICEF ambassador. And he likes to visit and to fulfill the dream of sick children.
